 - b. Copy of high school transcript or GED certificate.
 - c. Letter of acceptance from the school you are planning to attend or a schedule of classes for which you have been accepted.

Once the CSBG Program Application is completed at your local outreach office, your local FCD Specialist will submit the Scholarship Application along with the above items to Paige Hanks, Community Services Director. All Scholarship Applications need to be submitted by March 31, 2024.

Income Guidelines

Eligibility for the CSBG Scholarship Program is limited to households whose income does not exceed 125% of the Poverty Income Guidelines. Eligibility is determined by annualizing a household's most recent 90-day income.

CSBG Documentation Requirements

- Social Security Cards for the entire household
- State ID/Driver's License for everyone over 18 years of age
- Proof of 90-day income for the entire household
- High School Transcripts
- Proof attending a 2-year or 4-year Illinois College fulltime for Spring 2024
- 3 letters of recommendation
- · All CSBG forms completed with attached required documentation and scholarship forms
