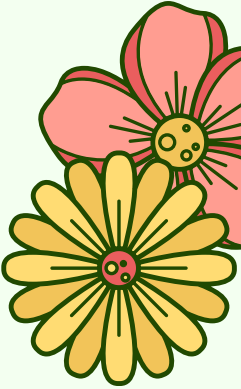


Last Night's Recap

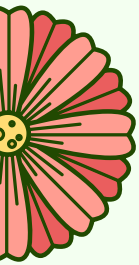
JV Baseball has a home game vs. Lincolnwood at 4:30





Prom guest permission slips and Post Prom permission slips need to be turned in by 3pm on April 19th.

Congratulations to the following students who competed in the FFA's Ag Mechanics CDE last night:

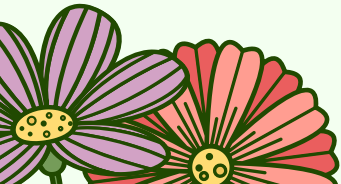
Cole Lantz placed 4th in Welding

There will be an FFA Meeting during pod today for all students working Ag Field Day tomorrow only.

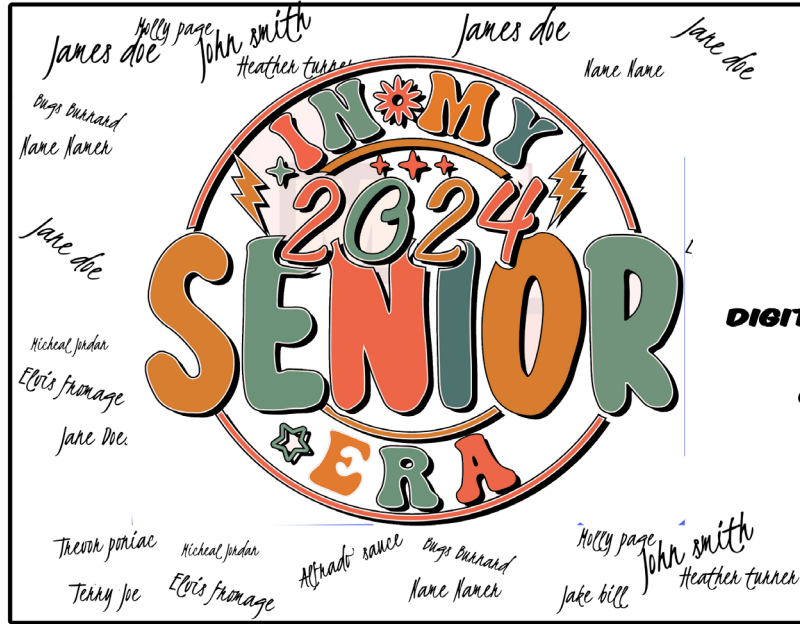




