Last Night's Recap

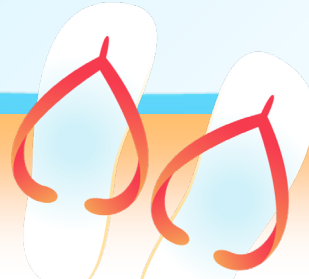


Girls track took first place overall at the County Meet.
