Board advised Dr. Goble that if TRO was issued to use positivity rate of Girard/Virden every Friday. If seven-day rolling average of the positivity rate is 15% or higher, masks will be required the following week. If the seven-day rolling average of the positivity rate is less than 15%, masks will be optional. Skylert will be created for families to advise of masking status for the following week.
